## 1. Policy Statement

Okanagan College is committed to providing a high -quality educational experience for all students and assisting students to complete their academic programs successfully. Academic Standing in its various forms applies to all current Okanagan College students and relates to students' eligibility to register in credit courses within an Okanagan College program and their eligibility to graduate from a program.

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## 3. Scope and Application

This policy applies primarily to students enrolled in academic degree, diploma or certificate programs and enrolled in a minimum of three cour ses per term.

This policy does not apply to Adult Upgrading, Continuing Studies Certificates, English Language Programs, or Accessible Education and Training.

4. Definitions

Academic Notice	Means that a student has not met a Term GPA of 55% after being in Good Standing. Academic Notice provides an opportunity for the student to seek appropriate supports to improve their GPA.	
Academic Probation	Means that a student has not met a Term GPA of 55% in two consecutive Terms and is therefore placed on Academic Probation.	
Academic Standing	Means an indication of a student's overall performance status and their eligibility to progress in their program of study. Academic Standing is determined at the end of each Term.	
Academic Suspension	Means Students has not met a Term GPA of 55% for a third consecutive Term and therefore will not be permitted to register in academic courses for 12 consecutive months following the end of Term that led to the suspension.	
Good Academic Standing	Means students have met the minimum Term GPA of 55% unless stated otherwise on their academic record.	
Term	Means fall Term, winter Term or combined summer sessions 1 and 2.	
Term Grade Point Average (GPA)	Means a student's grade point average (GPA) for the courses completed in one specific Term.

- ii) Inability to perform due to i llness or incapacity
- iii) Disruptive behaviour
- iv) Misconduct as defined in the Student Non-Academic Misconduct Policy
